Conduct civil construction wheeled front end loader operations

Course Information

This unit includes the skills and knowledge required operate a front-end loader to load, haul and distribute materials. This unit applies to those working in site-based roles and will provide you the skills and knowledge required to:

- Plan and prepare for wheeled front end loader operations.
- Operate front end loader in line with established requirements.
- Plan and prepare for backhoe loader operations.
- Operate backhoe loader in line with established requirements e.g. trenching, backfilling.
- Load, carry and place materials to complete work activity.
- Select, remove, fit and use attachments for a backhoe loader.
- Conduct housekeeping activities.

- Front end loader operator

Entry Requirements

To ensure the quality training outcomes, all candidates need to demonstrate sufficient academic capability to complete a unit of competency. These requirements are as following:

- Students must be aged 18 or older
- Ability to read, write and understand English
- Students must bring a Photo I.D.
- Wear steel cap boots
- Students must bring a hi-visibility vest
