

Overseas Student Health Cover Policy

1 PURPOSE

All overseas students are required by law to have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) prior to Visa approval. Students are to obtain this cover prior to entry into Australia and are to be covered from the day they arrive until the end of the issued Visa.

2 SCOPE

This policy applies to all Students who are making application to, or commencing study with Pal Education.

Exceptions: You do not need OSHC if you are:

- a Norwegian student covered by the Norwegian National Insurance Scheme
- a Swedish student covered by the National Board of Student Aid or by Kammarkollegiet
- a Belgian student covered under the Reciprocal Health Care Agreement with Australia.

3 POLICY STATEMENT

As a condition of the Student Visa, the Australian Government requires the student to have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).

The student must arrange OSHC themselves. Students will not be able to obtain a valid Student Visa, if they do not have proof of OSHC.

3.1 STUDENT ARRANGED HEALTH COVER

As part of the Application for Enrolment students are required to indicate whether they currently hold OSHC or if they will arrange OSHC cover later (prior to Visa application). If the student is to arrange cover, they are required to provide Pal Education with all details in order to validate a Confirmation of Enrolment.

Failure to obtain OSHC may result in your Student Visa application being denied.

Some Australian local Health Insurance providers may have different policies of COVID-19 Vaccination, please communicate with your health insurance company for detailed information.
